# SWEATER W/STRIPES

Raglan sweater Instruction: Liv Stangeland

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

## Measurements:

Chest width: (65) 70 (74) 77 (81) 87

Length: approx (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) 52 cm

Sleeve length: (23) 26 (29) 32 (35) 40 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

#### Yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA (100 % alpaca, 50 g = 150 m)
TYNN MERINOULL (100 % merino wool, 50 g = 175 m)

## Alternative yarn:

SISU, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

## Yarn required:

MINI ALPAKKA

Ink blue #6063: 2 balls all sizes Emerald #7755: 1 ball all sizes Golden ochre #2337: 1 ball all sizes Dusty green #7243: 1 ball all sizes TYNN MERINOULL

Ice blue #6531: 1 ball all sizes Dk.curry #2336: 1 ball all sizes

# Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

## Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

# Stripe pattern:

\*2 rnds ink blue, 2 rnds ice blue, 2 rnds dusty green, 2 rnds dk.curry, 2 rnds emerald 2 rnds golden ochre\*, Repeat from \*-\*.

## Sleeves:

With ink blue and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (44) 44 (48) 48 (52) 52 sts. Join and work (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Work 1 rnd St-st.

Change to 3 mm double pointed, and insert marker on first and last st of rnd

Cont St-st and **stripe pattern** and when sleeve meas 6 cm inc 1 st at each side of marker.

Rep inc approx every 2 cm until (60) 64 (68) 72 (76) 80 sts on rnd.

Cont until sleeve meas (23) 26 (29) 32 (35) 40 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off 8 center underarm sts (= marked st + 3 sts at each side).

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

### **Back and front:**

With ink blue and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (188) 200 (212) 220 (232) 248 sts. Join and work (2) 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Work 1 rnd St-st, **while** dec 12 sts evenly spaced = (176) 188 (200) 208 (220) 236 sts.

Insert marker at sides with (88) 94 (100) 104 (110) 118 sts for each part. Change to 3 mm circular, cont St-st and **stripe pattern** until garment meas approx. (23) 25 (28) 31 (34) 33 cm

**NOTE:** Meas sleeve to establish beginning of stripe pattern for ending at the same rnd of pattern as the sleeves.

Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers).

# Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (264) 284 (304) 320 (340) 364 sts. Insert marker at each junction.

Rnd beg at right side on the back. Cont St-st and **stripe pattern** and dec for raglan at each marker as follows:

\*k2tog, work until 2 sts before next marker, sl 1, k1, psso\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = 8 sts dec.

Rep dec on alt rnds a total of (16) 18 (21) 23 (25) 27 times = (136) 140 (136) 136 (140) 148 sts.

Transfer the (14) 16 (16) 18 (18) 20 center front sts to spare ndl for neck

and cont to end of rnd. Cut yarn and beg again at neck.

Cont St-st back and forth.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of every row at each side, at the same time cont raglan dec as before 4 times more and to a total of (20) 22 (25) 27 (29) 31 times of dec on sts for the back.

**NOTE:** Work raglan dec on RS. Leave rem sts on ndl for neck.

## Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

#### Neckband:

Transfer sts at neck to 2.5 mm circular ndl and with jnk blue knit up 1 st every st/row, but skip every 4th st row at neck edge to approx (104) 106 (108) 112 (118) 120 sts.

Work approx 6 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts.





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
