SEASON

Sweater in St-st w/embroiderv Instruction: Asa Christiansen

Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

Measurements:

Chest width: (66) 69 (74) 78 (82) 88

Length: approx (37) 42 (46) 50 (53)

55 cm

Sleeve length: (23) 26 (29) 32 (36) 40

cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

Yarn:

DUO (55 % merino wool, 45 % cotton, 50 g = 124 m

For embroidery:

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m)

Yarn required:

DUO

Lt.petrol #6553/ Pastel lilac #4631: (200) 200 (250) 300 (350) 400 g TYNN LINE for embroidery Slate #6080: 1 ball all sizes

Notions:

Buttons in various colors

Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3 mm and 3.5 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

Tension:

22 sts St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

Back and front:

With 3 mm circular ndl cast on (162) 168 (180) 190 (200) 216 sts. Join and work 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Change to 3.5 mm circular, k 1 rnd, while dec (16) 16 (18) 18 (20) 22 sts evenly spaced = (146) 152 (162) 172 (180) 194 sts.

Insert marker at sides with (73) 76 (81) 86 (90) 97 sts for each part.

Cont St-st in rnds until work meas (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 37 cm.

Cast off (8) 8 (8) 10 (10) 10 sts at each side for armholes (= (4) 4 (4) 5 (5) 5 sts at each side of markers). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

Sleeves:

With 3 mm double pointed ndls cast on (36) 38 (40) 42 (44) 46 sts. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3.5 mm double pointed, k 1 rnd, while inc (12) 14 (18) 18 (20) 20 sts evenly spaced = (48) 52 (58) 60 (64) 66 sts.

Cont St-st in rnds until sleeve meas (23) 26 (29) 32 (36) 40 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off (8) 8 (8) 10 (10) 10 center underarm sts.

Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

Raglan:

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3.5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast off = (210)224 (246) 252 (268) 286 sts.

Insert marker at each junction

Rnd beg at a marker on the back.

Cont St-st in rnds and dec for raglan at each marker as follows: k2tog after each marker, and k2tog tbl before each marker = 8 sts dec.

Rep raglan dec on alt rnds (14) 16 (18) 19 (20) 21 times = (98) 96 (102) 100 (108) 118 sts.

Transfer the (17) 18 (21) 22 (24) 25 center front sts to spare ndl for neck and cont to end of rnd. Cut yarn and beg at neck.

Dec for raglan on RS rows.

Cont back and forth, and dec for raglan 4 times more where this is possible, at the same time cast off at neck 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times at beg of every row at each side.

Leave rem sts on spare ndl.

Finishing:

Sew underarm openings.

Neckband:

Transfer sts on spare ndls to 3 mm circular, and knit up sts over cast-offs until approx (76) 78 (80) 82 (86) 96 sts on ndl. Number of sts a multiple of 2.

Work 2 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off rib-wise.

With TYNN LINE embroider tree motif with back stitches (see sketch). Sew buttons on (see photo).
