SIZES

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: (64) 68 (73) 76 (80) 86 cm
Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (50) 52 cm
Sleeve length: (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm
All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

YARN

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, TYNN ALPAKKA ULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

YARN REQUIRED

Rose-cheek #4012: (2) 3 (3) 4 (4) 5 balls
Lt.limestone #2319: (2) 2 (3) 3 (4) 5 balls
Yellow sand #2134: 1 ball all sizes
Dill #8552: 1 ball all sizes
Dusty petrol #7212: 1 ball all sizes
Pink #4524: 1 ball all sizes
Black #1099: 1 ball all sizes

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

TENSION

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

BACK AND FRONT

With rose-cheek and 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on (172) 184 (196) 204 (216) 232 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3 mm circular ndl. Insert marker at sides with (86) 92 (98) 102 (108) 116 sts for each part. Cont St-st and stripe [diagram](#) in rnds until garment meas (23) 25 (28) 30 (31) 32 cm. Cast off 8 sts at each side for armholes (= 4 sts at each side of markers). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

SLEEVES

With rose-cheek and 2.5 mm double pointed ndls cast on (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 sts. Join and work (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Change to 3 mm double pointed ndls, work St-st and stripe [diagram](#), while inc (18) 22 (24) 28 (30) 34 sts evenly spaced on first rnd = (60) 66 (70) 76 (80) 86 sts on rnd. Cont stripe [diagram](#) until sleeve meas (24) 27 (30) 33 (36) 40 cm. Cast off 8 middle underarm sts. Put aside and work other sleeve the same.

RAGLAN

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 3 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (260) 284 (304) 324 (344) 372 sts. Work St-st and stripe [diagram](#), k2tog at each junction and insert marker on each of these 4 sts = (256) 280 (300) 320 (340) 368 sts and 4 markers. Cont stripe [diagram](#) and dec for raglan at each junction as follows: Work until 1 st before marker, sl 2 sts k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, k2tog = 8 sts dec. Rep dec on alt rnds (11) 14 (16) 17 (19) 22 times = (168) 168 (172) 184 (188) 192 sts on rnd. Transfer the (14) 14 (16) 16 (18) 20 middle front sts to spare ndl for neck, and cont to

end of rnd. Cut yarn, and beg again at neck. Cont stripe [diagram](#) back and forth, and cast off 2 sts at beg of every row at each side at neck, at the same time cont raglan dec where possible (8) 8 (8) 9 (9) 9 times more, and until a total of (19) 22 (24) 26 (28) 31 times over sts for the back.

NOTE: Dec for raglan on RS rows. Leave rem sts on ndl for neckband.

Finishing:

Sew tog underarm openings.

Neckband:

Transfer sts at neck to small 2.5 mm circular ndl, and at the same time knit up sts at neck edge with rose-cheek. K 1 rnd while adjusting number of sts to (104) 108 (112) 116 (120) 124. Work 8 cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds. Cast off rib-wise. Fold neckband to WS and sew loosely with hidden sts. With knit sts embroider unicorn motif at front of garment (see photo)
