# SWEATER W/FLOUNCE

Sweater worked from neck down. Round yoke and flounce Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

#### Sizes:

(2) 4 (6) 8 (10) yrs

### Measurements:

Chest width: (64) 67 (70) 77 (80) cm Length: (36) 40 (44) 48 (52) cm Sleeve length: (25) 29 (31) 35 (38) cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### Yarn:

SISU (80 % wool, 20 % nylon, 50 g = 175 m)

## Alternative yarn:

MINI ALPAKKA, MANDARIN PETIT, ALPAKKA SILKE, TYNN MERINOULL, BABYULL LANETT, TYNN ALPAKKA ULL

Note: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn

# Yarn required:

Rose-cheek #4012: (3) 3 (4) 5 (5) balls

Lt.purle melange #5224: 1 ball all

Yellow sand #2134: 1 ball all sizes Lt.limestone #2319: 1 ball all sizes Dill #8552: 1 ball all sizes

Terracotta #3544: 1 ball all sizes

## Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 2.5 mm and 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

## Tension:

27 sts St-st with 3 mm ndls = 10 cm

### Inc 1 st:

Pick up yarn between 2 sts and k tbl this new st.

# **GSR = German Short Rows:**

After each turning, always sl first st p-wise (as working p2tog) with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl, pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on right ndl.

The 2 loops count as 1 stitch.

When working row with loops, work loops tog = 1 st.

## Work sweater from neck down.

With It.purple melange and small 2.5 mm circular ndl cast on loosely (96) 100 (104) 108 (112) sts. Join and work (10) 12 (14) 14 (16) rnds k1, p1. K 1 rnd **while** inc (18) 20 (22) 24 (26) sts evenly spaced = (114) 120 (126) 132 (138) sts.

Insert marker at beg of rnd = center back.

Change to 3 mm circular ndl.

Work extra height at back of sweater with **GSR** (as explained above) as follows:

K (17) 19 (21) 23 (25) sts, turn, p (33) 37 (41) 45 (49) sts, turn. Cont St-st and turn in the same manner but 4 sts <u>passed</u> previous turning and work loops tog. Cont until a total of 3 turnings at each side. K 1 rnd over all sts.

Change to yellow sand.

Work (10) 11 (13) 14 (15) rnds St-st. Change to It.limestone.

Work (10) 11 (13) 14 (15) rnds St-st, at the same time inc as follows on 2nd rnd: \*k3, inc 1 as explained above\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = (152) 160 (168) 176 (184) sts.

Change to dill.

Work (10) 11 (13) 14 (15) rnds St-st, at the same time inc as follows on 2nd rnd: \*k4, inc 1\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = (190) 200 (210) 220 (230) sts.

Work 1 rnd p (for picking up sts for flounce later), then work 2 rnds St-st.

Change to rose-cheek.

K 2 rnds, **while** inc on last rnd as follows: \*k5, inc 1\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd = (228) 240 (252) 264 (276) sts. Work (3) 3 (5) 5 (6) rnds St-st and inc (28) 24 (28) 52 (48) sts evenly spaced on 2nd rnd = (256) 264 (280) 316 (324) sts.

Divide work as follows:

Work (39) 40 (42) 47 (48) sts (=  $\frac{1}{2}$  back), transfer (49) 51 (55) 63 (65) sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on (7) 9 (9) 9 (11) new underarm sts, work (80) 82 (86) 96 (98) sts (= front), transfer (49) 51 (55) 63 (65) sts to spare ndl for sleeve, cast on (7) 9 (9) 9 (11) new underarm sts, work (39) 40 (42) 47 (48) sts (=  $\frac{1}{2}$  back).

## **Back and front:**

= (172) 180 (188) 208 (216) sts. Beg rnd at middle underarm st in one side.

With rose-cheek and 3 mm circular ndl work St-st until garment meas approx (33) 36 (40) 43 (47) cm, meas from after ribbing at center back and straight down, or (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm before suitable length.

Change to 2.5 mm circular ndl and work (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm ribbing k1, p1. Cast off loosely rib-wise. Use a thicker ndl for a flexible cast-off edge.

#### Sleeves.

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 3 mm double pointed ndls and with rose-cheek knit up 1 st each new underarm st = (56) 60 (64) 72 (76) sts on rnd.

Insert marker at middle underarm = beg of rnd.

Cont St-st with rose-cheek until sleeve meas  $(3\frac{1}{2})$   $3\frac{1}{2}$  (3)  $2\frac{1}{2}$   $(2\frac{1}{2})$  cm.

Dec 2 sts at middle underarm as follows:

Work until 1 st <u>before</u> marked st, sl 2 k-wise (as working k2tog), k1, psso = 2 sts dec.

Rep dec approx every  $(3\frac{1}{2})$   $3\frac{1}{2}$  (3)  $2\frac{1}{2}$   $(2\frac{1}{2})$  cm until (46) 48 (50) 50 (52) sts rme on rnd.

Cont until sleeve meas (22) 25 (27) 30 (33) cm, or (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm before suitable length.

Change to 2.5 mm double pointed ndls, and work (3) 4 (4) 5 (5) cm ribbing k1, p1 in rnds.

Cast off loosely rib-wise. Use a thicker ndl for a flexible cast-off edge.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

# Flounce:

Beg at center back.

With terracotta and 3 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st in every st on p rnd = (190) 200 (210) 220 (230) sts.

K 1 rnd, at the same time inc 1 st in each alt st as follows: k1 and k1 tbl in the same st = (285) 300 (315) 330 (345) sts.

Work (8) 9 (11) 12 (13) rnds St-st. Next rnd: work \*k2tog, 1 yo\*, rep from \*-\* in the rnd.

Cast off loosely p-wise.
