GIANT
BLANKET*Blanket**Instruction: Uldfisker by Nanna Exner***Size:**

Approx 200x200 cm

Yarn:TYKK ULL (100% Norwegian wool,
50 g = 35 m)**Yarn required:**

Natural #1012: 46 balls

Suggested knitting needles:

Double pointed and circular 10 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your
knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker
needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.**Tension:**

9 sts St-st with 10 mm ndls = 10 cm

Beg at center of the square.

With 10 mm double pointed ndls cast
on 8 sts and spread sts on 4 ndls.
Join and insert marker at beg of rnd.
Work **diagram** in rnds of 4 pattern
repeats. Increase as shown in
diagram and change to circ ndl when
sufficient sts on rnd.

When diagram is finished, transfer sts
to a spare thread.

Work a total of 9 squares.

Finishing:

Knit 2 squares tog as follows:

Transfer sts from one side of each
square back to 10 mm ndls. Place
squares with RS facing each other
and k 1 st from each ndl tog **and at
the same time** cast off.

Cont in this manner to form the giant
blanket of 3x3 squares.

Edging:

Transfer sts at one long edge to 10
mm circ ndl.

K 4 rows back and forth and inc 1 st
at beg of every row as follows: k1
in front and back of first st. Cast off
loosely.

Rep this on the 3 other sides of
blanket.

Sew tog at corners. Fasten ends by
splitting yarn in two and fasten each
part separately.

Wash and use spin cycle of the
washer.

Let blanket dry flat and stretch it in
shape when still wet.
