# MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (108) 120 (132) cm Length: (77) 80 (82) cm Sleeve length: 25 cm, or suitable length All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

#### YARN

TYNN LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 220 m) SILK MOHAIR (60 % kid mohair, 15 % wool, 25 % silk, 50 g = 280 m)

# YARN REQUIRED

TYNN LINE Dusty pastel blue #7521: (4) 5 (6) balls SILK MOHAIR Dusty pastel blue #7521: (3) 3 (4) balls

# SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 5 mm Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle

#### TENSION

17 sts St-st with double yarn (1 strand TYNN LINE + 1 strand SILK MOHAIR) and 5 mm ndls = 10 cm

#### WORK GARMENT IN ST-ST WITH DOUBLE YARN AND TURN WORK INSIDE OUT WHEN FINISHED.

#### **BACK AND FRONT**

With double yarn and 5 mm circular ndl cast on loosely (184) 204 (224) sts. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds. Insert marker at each side with (92) 102 (112) sts for each part. Cont St-st in rnds until garment meas (50) 51 (51) cm. Cast off 12 sts at each side for armholes (= 6 sts at each side of markers). Put garment aside and work sleeves.

# SLEEVES

With double yarn and 5 mm double pointed ndls cast on loosely (36) 40 (44) sts. Join and work 5 cm ribbing k2, p2 in rnds. Insert marker around first and last st on rnd. Cont St-st and inc 1 st at each side of marker. Rep inc every 2½ cm until (52) 56 (60) sts on ndl.

Cont until sleeve meas 25 cm, or suitable length. Cast off 12 middle underarm sts. Work other sleeve in the same manner.

# RAGLAN DEC

Transfer sleeve sts to the circular 5 mm garment ndl, placing one sleeve above each armhole cast-off = (240) 268 (296) sts. Insert marker around 6 sts at each junction and work p over these sts further.

Work (2) 0 (0) rnds over sts as they appear. \*Dec for raglan as follows: sl 1, k1, psso <u>after</u> each marker, k2tog <u>before</u> each marker = 8 sts dec.

Work 1 rnd without dec.

Dec for raglan in this manner but over sts for back and front only = 4 sts dec. Work 2 rnds without dec\*, rep from \*-\* a total of (12) 13 (14) times, <u>at the same time</u> after (10) 11 (12) times of dec (= (120) 136 (152) sts on ndl) transfer the (14) 18 (22) middle front sts for neck to spare ndl. Cont to end of rnd. Cut yarn. Beg again at neck and cont back and forth. Cast off 3 sts 5 times at beg of every row at each side, and cont raglan dec where possible.

#### FINISHING

Turn garment inside out.

#### NECKBAND

Transfer sts from spare ndl to 5 mm circular ndl and at the same time knit up sts (k tbl) at neck edge front.

Work 1 rnd over sts as they appear <u>while</u> adjusting number of sts to (110) 115 (125). Work 10 cm ribbing p3, k2 in rnds. Dec 1 st at each p section on last rnd = (22) 23 (25) sts dec. Cont 5 cm ribbing k2, p2. Cast off rib-wise. Sew underarm openings.
